ABOUT MOONLIGHT STAGE PRODUCTIONS

Moonlight Stage Productions was founded by Producing Artistic Director Kathy Brombacher and its first two-show season was presented in 1981. Originally a collaborative program between the City of Vista and the Unified School District, the Moonlight was formally placed under the umbrella of the City in 1984. The Moonlight is the cultural arts program of the City of Vista and offers a summer season of three musicals at the Moonlight Amphitheatre. In the winter months, from January through April, the Moonlight presents an indoor winter season at its intimate AVO Playhouse located in the heart of the Vista Village. The Moonlight Amphitheatre has a capacity of 2000 people, while the AVO Playhouse seats 385.

At the close of the 2008 Summer Season, the original Amphitheatre stage was demolished to make way for the new state-of-the-art stage house which opened in July 2009. The new stage house features an enlarged stage, a scenic construction shop, costume construction room, a rehearsal room and dressing rooms. The Amphitheatre was also upgraded to include a new south entrance box office, and ADA compliant amenities.

The Moonlight Cultural Foundation has played a significant role in the growth of the Moonlight programs since 1974 when the Foundation was founded. The Moonlight Cultural Foundation is the non-profit fundraising arm of Moonlight Stage Productions and each year raises funding through corporate sponsorships and patron programs.
